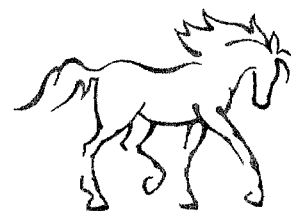

### WHO GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES Nov. 28, 2009 Red Lion Hotel Salem Oregon

Also the Junior show will be the first weekend in July and the WHO summer show will be the last weekend of July.

**Show information/news:** Tully reported that the ground at Canby has been re-worked and the fairgrounds people are very willing to try and make it good all the time.

**Annual Awards:** Amber not present. Tully reminded all to thank Amber for all the hard work she does each year on awards.

**Interstate:** Clark County Fairgrounds for the next 2 years. Camping to be \$15.00 for the weekend, stalls \$19.00 per day. Can only arrive on Thursday. Riders can also get sponsorships/ads and for \$200 in ads can get 1 stall and camping free. Next meeting to be Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

**Junior Director:** One scholarship application to be given out at dinner. Sandy reported that she had a great year with great kids. Thanks!

**Historian:** Wendy not present and unable to do historian book for next year.

**Old business:** None

**New business:** Kathy Moody reported just FYI that PSHA voted that their members can ride at Oregon shows and have times count in Washington. Show secretary must sign a completed show sheet to verify that the run was made and the time it was run in.

### **Rule Change Proposals reviewed by Board**

Rule Change proposed by Bill Neely

Current Rule: Beat Washington Show

Proposal: Change the name to WHO State Championship Show. It would be a one day Saturday show.

(PROPOSAL FAILED)

Rule change proposed by Bill Neely

Current rule: Added money, entry fee \$2.70, Budget \$2,100

Proposed Rule: Entry \$3.00, Budget \$2,900, Added money to remain same, there will be a championship award given to: High Point Jr, Senior, 4-man team, 2-man team and fastest time in all 5 individual events.

(PROPOSAL PASSED, MICK CATES MOVED THAT THE PROPOSAL BE AMENDED TO BE RELATIVE TO ONLY THE BEAT WASHINGTON MEET, DEAN SECONDED AND AMENDMENT WAS PASSED)

Rule Change proposed by Bill Neely

Proposed Rule: Championship Show to be the last Saturday of July.

(PROPOSAL FAILED)

Rule change proposed by Sandy Neely (is no current rule)

Proposed rule: In individual pole bending, poles shall not be reset when knocked down.

(PROPOSAL PASSED).

Rule change proposed by Sandy Neely

Proposed rule: Team Pole Bending—Poles shall be reset, if possible, when knocked down.

(PROPOSAL PASSED)

Rule proposal by Tosha Ferrando

Top Ten year end awards shall be given to 4 divisions instead of two (Jr/Sr) with this breakdown: JR 18 yrs and below, Intermediate 19—29, Senior 30—45 and Senior B of 46 and over. Awards given to the top ten in each category. Budgeting as follows: \$1,000 per saddle per age group and \$800 for placings 2-10. New cost of this could be \$3,600 from the general fund each year, not to exceed a total of \$7,200. Sponsors and donations would be sought after.

Rule proposal made by Heath Ferrando

New Rule Proposal: Any knocked down or missed property in any individual event is considered a No Time or disqualification.

Reason for proposal: Easier for time keepers and point secretaries.
